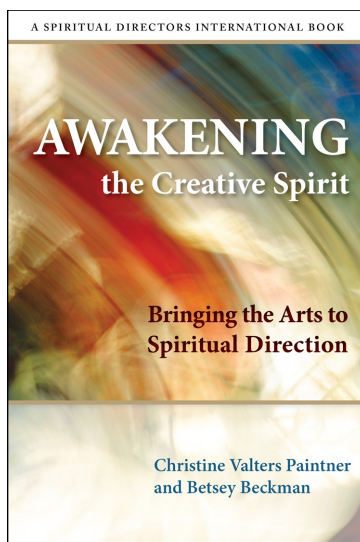


**A four-day experiential intensive with a focus on deepening and expanding skills to integrate the arts and imagination into spiritual direction ministry.**
